Summary

An original format to organise mini workshops, involving a course of 40 minutes, which presents a topic on large interactive screens. It is an original model designed for the exploring eLearning event, the first national event on eLearning for companies (www.exploring-elearning.com)

What is it?

The posterLab is a focused learning experience, a new way of training that focuses on the questions of the participants and the sharing of experiences to develop answers together. The posterLab stimulates the different intelligences each of us has through a multiplicity of languages and tools: multi-media videos, face to face discussions between participants, summary visual thinking and interactive APPS specifically developed for interaction. Thanks to the APP, the participants can post, on a big whiteboard, interactive questions, ideas, suggestions but also practical actions to be applied in the workplace.

Each posterLab is organised in five steps: 1) agreement on the questions; 2) screening of the summary video; 3) testimonials; 4) discussions and knowledge sharing; 5) final summary.

What is its purpose?

- enable moments of discussion and for exchanging ideas
- make learning easier and more dynamic, mixing different methodologies
- innovate classroom based training, increasing its attractiveness and thus the motivation of those involved in the educational process
