

COMPULSORY TRAINING

In brief

Courses designed for being in compliance with compulsory training on regulations for safety, privacy, computer security, 231, and anti-corruption laws, in full conformity with current regulations.

What is it?

Using e-learning in order to comply with compulsory training on regulations is becoming increasingly widespread for its obvious advantages in terms of organisation, time and cost. Using a carefully balanced mix of different educational languages and communication, such as television simulations, cartoon drawings, visual thinking, and animated cartoons can help encourage the participants to get involved and motivated, overcoming the resistance often linked to complex issues but that are required by law.

What is it for?

- transforming an "obbligation" into a moment of great involvement, awareness, and responsibility
- integrating training about regulatory aspects with behavioural training, thus making the educational impact significantly more effective
- simplifying complex concepts, making them accessibile, clear and memorable
