Cards For Learning Design are actual playing cards for the creation of blended training paths.

What are they?

Cards For Learning Design consist of three decks of cards:

FORMAT: This deck contains the main formats used in the macro-design of a training path. Different formats can coexist and combine in a single path, in a blended logic.

EDUCATIONAL STRATEGIES: This deck contains the various educational strategies that the training designer can play when micro-designing courses. The methods shown on the cards relate to the macro-strategies for the presentation of information, the content delivery sequence and techniques to foster the learning and assimilation of concepts.

MULTIMEDIA LANGUAGES: This deck of cards contains some of the multimedia languages used in the design of on-line training modules.

What are they for?

Cards For Learning Design:

- involve and engage both the recipients of training and their relative trainers
- foster the learning and assimilation of concepts using completely new training logic
- assist the training designer to search for new educational strategies
